- All 7th grade students **MUST** have been administered a TDAP and Meningococcal vaccine before **September 15**. Students who do not have these vaccines will not be allowed to return to school.
- 8th grade students who are interested in applying to Magnet Programs for high school are encouraged to attend the BCPS Magnet Expo on Saturday, September 30. Magnet applications will be available on September 12 and must be submitted by November 3.

Start Administering Vaccines Early (S.A.V.E.)

Bring your child to a Baltimore County health center in your area to get needed shots, or make an appointment with your pediatrician as soon as possible.

Free vaccine is available for those who:

- Have Medical Assistance or MCHP
- Have no health insurance
- Have health insurance that does not pay for vaccine
- Are 18 years old or younger
- Attend a BCDH Mass Vaccine Clinic

Did you know Baltimore County Public Schools require:

- ✓ Two Varicella vaccines (Chicken Pox) for students entering grades K-9.
- ✓ A Tdap vaccine (Whooping Cough) and a Meningococcal vaccine (meningitis) for students entering grades 7-12.
- ✓ Scheduled immunizations administered by September 15, or student will not be allowed to return to school.
